Results 2023/24

EYFS:

73% of pupils achieved a good level of development in 2024 (Local Authority 69.6% 2024) and national 67.7% 2024) +5% when compared to national

Phonics screening:

100% of pupils passed the phonics test (Local Authority 81.3% and national 79% 2023) +21% when compared to national

*Year 6:

Reading - average scaled score 105.4 in 2024 (national 105 2024) +0.4 when compared to national

Reading - achieved standard 74% in 2024 (local 74.8% (2024) and national 74.2% 2024) -0.2% when compared to national

Writing - achieved standard 78.3% in 2024 - moderated by CYC (local 70.9% (2024) and national 71.7% 2024) +6.6% when compared to national

Maths - average scaled score 104.9 in 2024 (national 104.1 2024) +0.8 when compared to national

Maths - achieved standard 83% in 2024 (local 74.6% (2024) and national 73% 2024) +9.6% when compared to national

Grammar, punctuation & spelling - average scaled score 104.8 in 2024 (national 105 2024) - 0.2% when compared to national

Grammar, punctuation & spelling - achieved standard 78% in 2024 (local 73.5% 2022) and national 72% 2024) +6% when compared to national

Reading, writing and maths combined - achieved standard 65.2% in 2024 (local 61.6% 2024) and national 60.5% (2024) +4.7% when compared to national.

KS2 progress data is not available for the years 2023/24 and 2024/25 due to the impact of Covid-19 on KS1 prior attainment data - DfE.

* One child who joined Elvington midway through Year 5 (dual placement) did not take the KS2 assessments, however, they are included in all data sets. The aforementioned equates to 4.3%.
