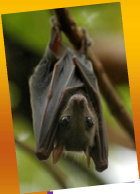


Welcome to Class 3 Bats!

- ❖ **Other useful websites:** Hit the button and URbrainy to increase timestable knowledge and fluency.



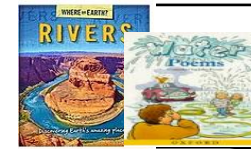

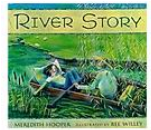

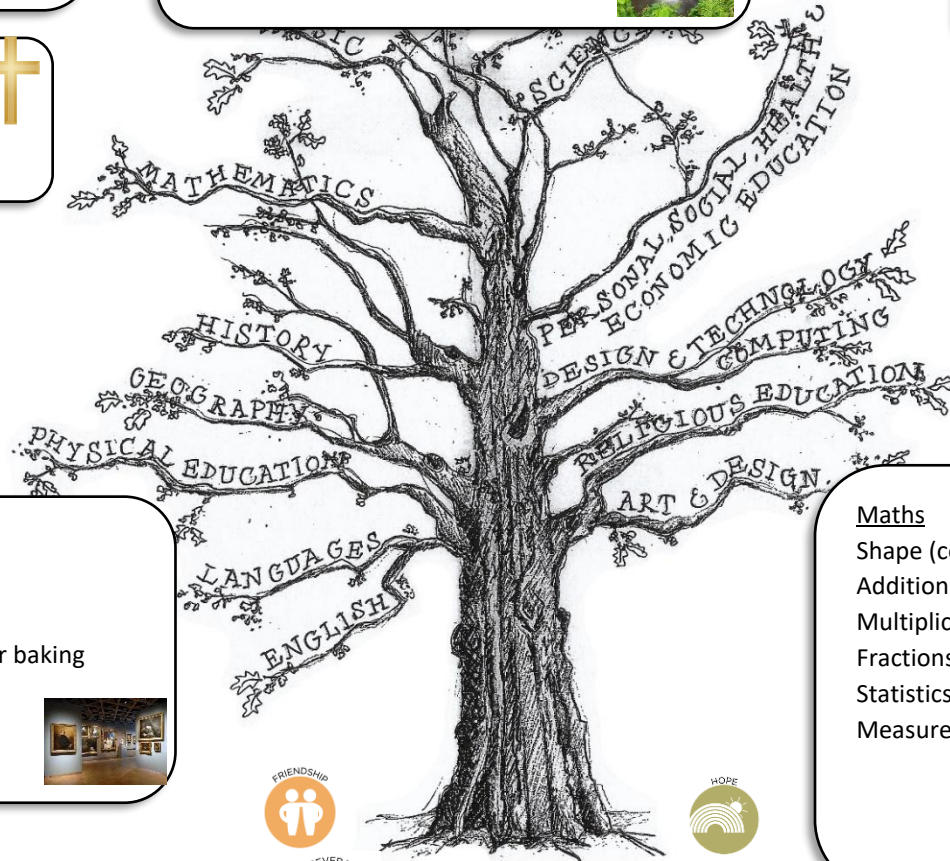
