How can you help at home?

<u>Reading</u> - Please encourage your child to tell a story from the pictures within their reading book. This should be for no longer than 5 minutes each evening. After reading, please record this in your child's planner. This could just be a 'well done' and the page your child will be on next.

<u>Phonics</u> A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. You will also receive a pack to place your child's flashcards in as they receive a new set each week. Phonics homework and the flashcard pack will be given out each Friday and should be returned a week later.

<u>Homework book-</u> Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Home Sweet Home" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the following Thursday to be marked. Compulsory activities are highlighted in purple and should be handed in on the date specified.


