How can you help at home?



- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work to learn at home ready for a mini quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned a week later.

- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Home Sweet Home" covering a range of curricular areas.
