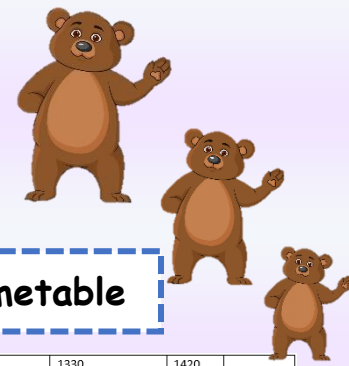


# Class 2 Bears- Spring 1
