How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task and weekly spellings will continue to be given each Friday (please ensure their folder comes to school **every Friday**). Please continue to help your child practise these at home. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every **Friday** and should be returned the following **Thursday**. **Year 1 spellings will increase this half term from 4 spellings to 6.**
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on the following websites at home.
- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "*Elvington and the Chocolate Story*" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next **Friday** to be marked.

Topic: Starry Night

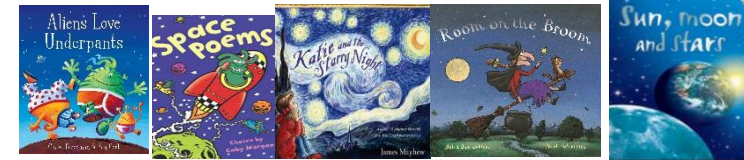


Geography:
