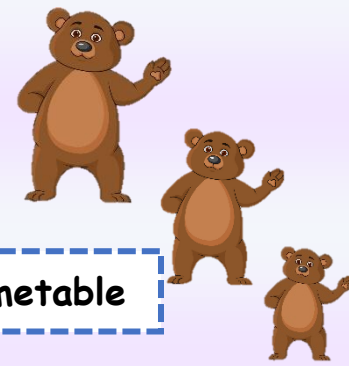

*Looking at the famous artist Vincent Van Gogh and his famous piece- Starry Night.



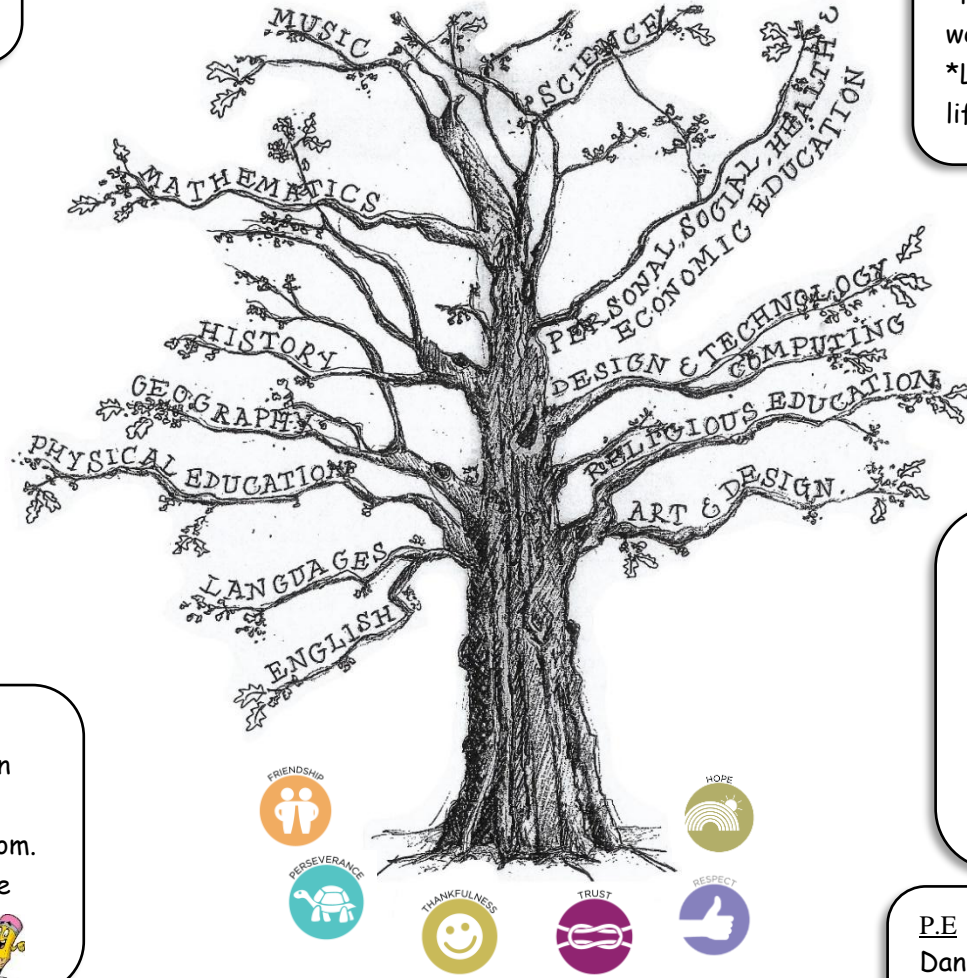
