- * Homework, spelling and times table book each Friday.

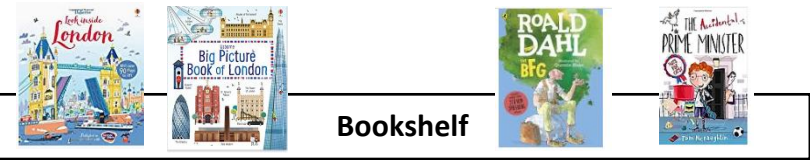


How can you help at home?
